

# NOTICE OF RACE

El Toro 2009 Junior North American Championship  
Stockton Sailing Club, Stockton, CA  
**Friday, July 17, 2009**

**SPONSORS:** Richmond Yacht Club, Santa Cruz Yacht Club, and Stockton Sailing Club.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All sailors who were under age 15 on January 31, 2009, and who are Junior Members of the El Toro Class.

**ENTRIES:** This year's championship will be an integral part of the Stockton Junior Sailing Camp (July 12 to 18, 2009). Advanced and intermediate juniors attending the Camp are automatically entered, at no extra charge. Juniors not attending the Camp may enter at any time before 10:00 a.m. on July 17.

**FEES:** Sailcampers who are also Class Members: No additional fee.  
Sailcampers who are not Class Members: \$15 (class membership)  
Class Members who are not Sailcampers: \$20 (regatta fee)  
Sailors who are neither Sailcampers nor Class Members: \$35 (regatta entry fee & class membership).

**EQUIPMENT:** PFD's required. All equipment used by a competitor (hull, sail, masts, boom, centerboard, rudder, etc.) must conform to the El Toro Class Rules. Particular attention should be directed to rules VII.J.3 (mast butt positively secured) and VIII.C.4. (15' painter required). The use of running rigging will not meet the requirement of either rule, i.e., competitors may not rely on sail control lines to retain the mast in the step, and must have a dedicated 15' painter or bow line.

**OVERVIEW:** The event will be a three race series. If there is sufficient participation, there will be a Gold Fleet and a Silver Fleet, with separate starts. Placement of competitors in a Fleet will be at the discretion of the Race Committee, based in part on skill levels demonstrated at the Camp. Weather permitting, the warning signal for the first race will be at 11:00 a.m. and no races will be started after 3:45 p.m. If conditions permit, there will be a short break for lunch; competitors should take water and a snack with them in case no lunch break is feasible.
