

2010 Fremont Relays

The 7th annual Fremont Relays were held on Sunday May 16th on beautiful Lake Elizabeth in Fremont.

This year we had 32 skippers in 16 El Toro's sailing in light to moderate winds and cool (temperature wise) airs. For the first time in several years all of the boats stayed dry, giving our crash boat driver, an uneventful day on the water.
